

What is the DisPatch Server?

The *DisPatch* Server is the control center of the *DisPatch ProNet* system and is covered under warranty for five years with a subscription. It provides centralized logging and storage while serving as the management console for OS patches, antivirus definitions, intrusion detection signatures, and centralized backups.

Each *ProNet* subscription requires either the Basic or Advanced *DisPatch* Server. Both come with ten Client Access Licenses (CAL) standard, with additional CALs available in increments of five.

Server Options

Basic

- ▶ Best for smaller sites with fewer HMIs or limited growth of storage needs
- ▶ Single quad core processor
- ▶ Integrated storage of 2TB (RAID 1 Mirroring)

Advanced Server

- ▶ Best for mid-size to larger sites or smaller sites with significant growth potential
- ▶ Dual quad core processor
- ▶ Starts at 4TB (RAID 5 Striping/Parody with Hot Spare)
- ▶ Redundant power

NOTE: A detached hard disk array is available with either server to provide scalable storage.

Centralized Backups

The backup utility minimizes downtime by recovering complete image backups in minutes. It supports manual, scheduled, and automated backups, improving IT productivity and ensuring quick and easy data recovery. A real-time dashboard overview of all configured and running operations highlights any processes requiring attention.

The Basic and Advanced *DisPatch* Servers come loaded with a backup utility and the capability and space to store images as specified in the utility.

Centralized Patch Management

DisPatch Servers also host the patch management utility for distributing operating system updates. The *DisPatch ProNet* monthly update kits include one disk of OS and security patches that are deployed on the server and pushed to the HMIs.
